

Criteria and guidance notes
for applications to
The Meads Fund
at Sussex Community Foundation

The Meads Fund at Sussex Community Foundation is looking to fund Eastbourne based charities addressing disadvantage and supporting people and communities within Eastbourne.

The Foundation seeks to build stronger more resilient communities by addressing disadvantage and deprivation. It believes that long term change comes from within a community and The Meads Fund will award one grant of £20,000 to the organisation who most clearly demonstrates their ability to achieve this change.

What can you apply for

A grant of up to £20,000 is available. There are no restrictions on what you may apply for, except that we will not support capital projects.

Who can apply

The fund is open to volunteer led not for profit organisations and charities working in Eastbourne with an annual income of up to £750,000.

Process for applying

Organisations who meet the criteria above and who wish to apply should use the Meads Fund application form.

This is a two stage application process; applications selected from the first stage will be contacted by the end of September to arrange a visit. Applications will subsequently be presented to a panel and you will be informed of the outcome by the end of November.

The grant will be allocated on an annual basis for 3 years subject to satisfactory end of year 1 and 2 monitoring reports. *****
