### Commentary

Overall, child poverty in Sussex is very similar to the South East, which was also the case at the time of the last report in 2013. However, there are some extremes within Sussex, such as Hastings, which has much higher levels of child poverty at 29%. Mid Sussex and Horsham have the lowest levels of child poverty at 8% jointly.
